## A Message from IAVE's World President and Executive Director

Greeting friends, colleagues, volunteers,

When International Volunteer Day was established on 17 December 1985 by the United Nations the resolution recognised the role of volunteer services in '...making an important contribution to socioeconomic development activities' and 'the desirability of stimulating the work of all volunteers both in the field and in organisations ...and of giving encouragement to those volunteers, many of whom engage in volunteer service at considerable personal sacrifice' and governments and other stakeholders were invited to observe annually, on 5 December, the work of volunteers.

"Volunteering is a fundamental building block of civil society. It brings to life the noblest aspiration of humankind – the pursuit of peace, freedom, opportunity, safety and justice for all people."

Wherever you are in the world, whatever the volunteer work you do or support, and however you celebrate International Volunteer Day, on behalf of IAVE we say thank you for the blocks you build, the aspirations you pursue and the change you make.
